

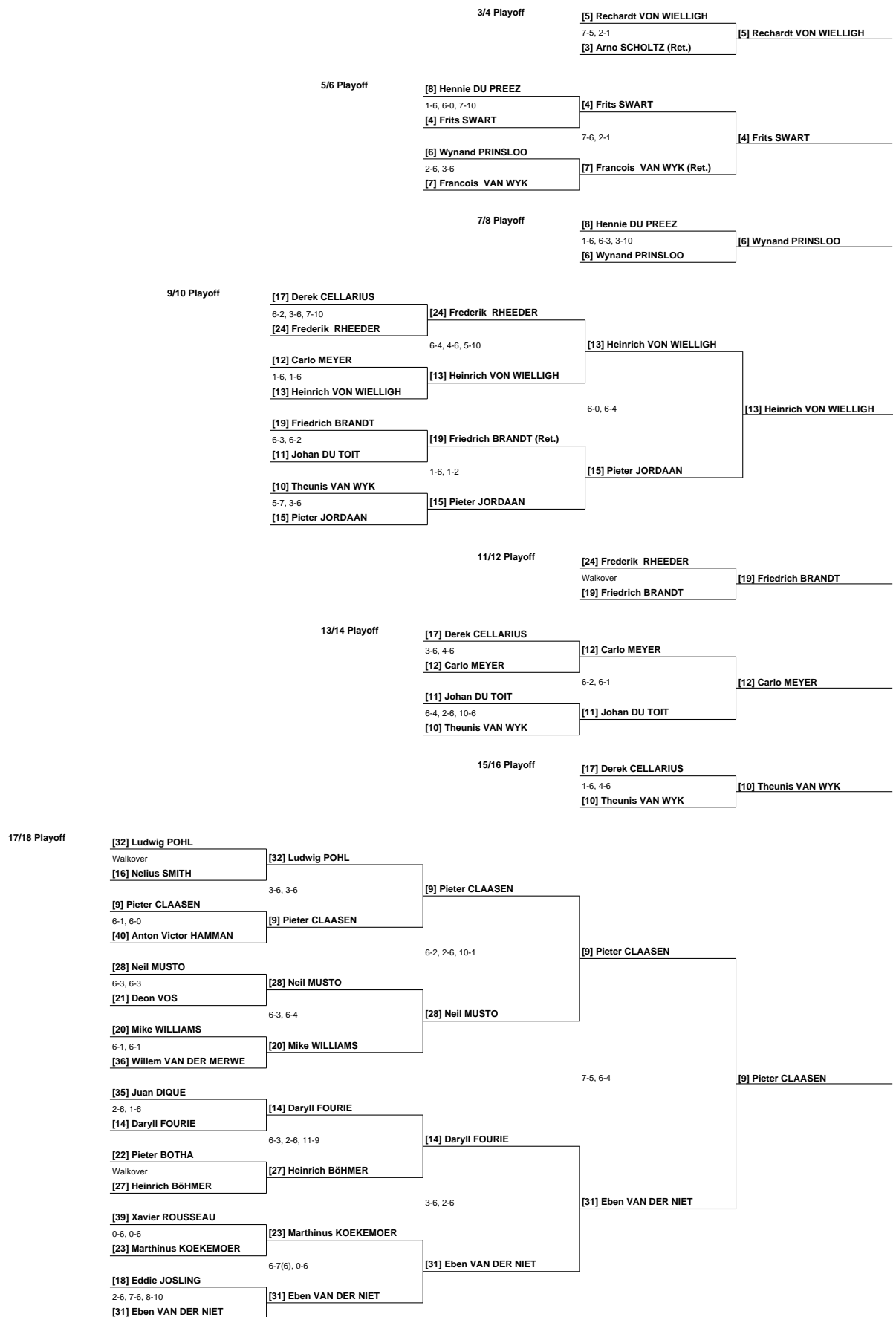
Main Draw

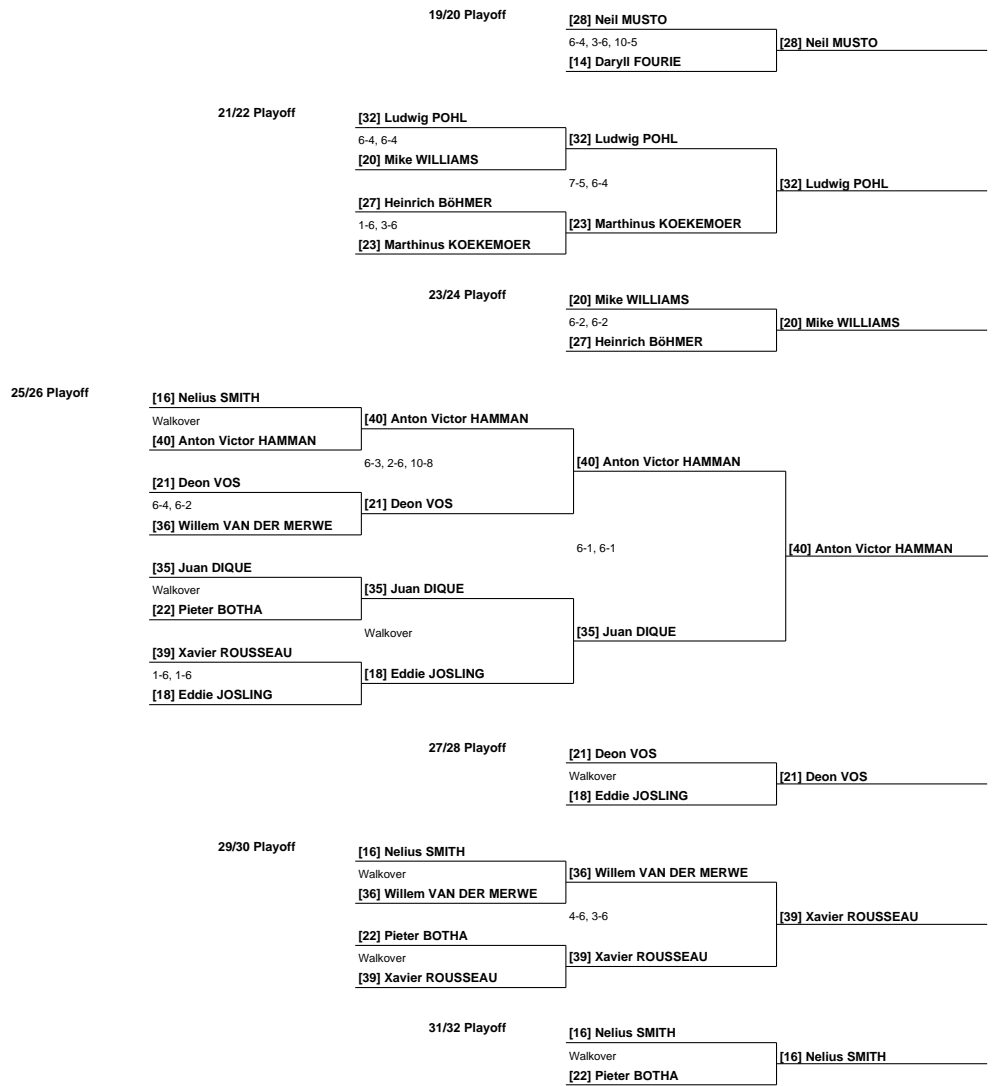

- Fourth Place:** Eben VAN DER NIET (NED)

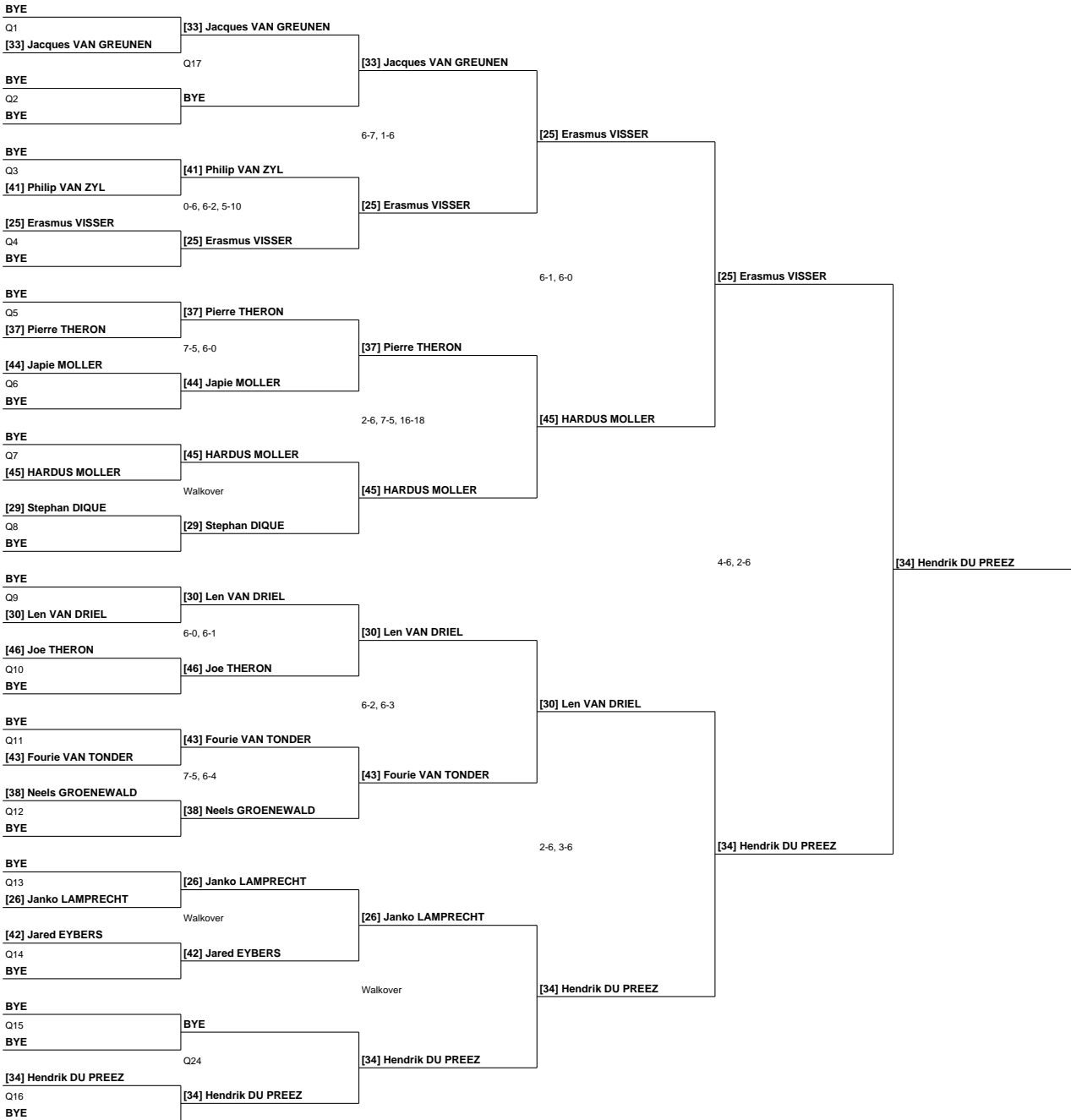
The bracket also includes numerous walkovers and byes, indicating the progression of athletes who did not compete in a particular round. The final results are summarized in the table below:
